

## **Keowee Anglers Board Meeting February 11, 2016**

Karl Hoinkes called the meeting to order at 9:32 AM at The Seneca Family Restaurant.

### **Treasurer's Report - John Wilson** (written submission)

- Bank Balance – \$2,437.71
- Membership Count – Total 109
- Inventory – Lure Covers 119, CD's 6, patches 3, and hat bands 5.

### **Tournament Director's Report – Bill Walker**

- A discussion was held on the date for the November 2016 tournament as The Lighthouse Activity Center is unavailable for our awards luncheon scheduled for Thursday, November 3rd. The following options are open –
  1. Delay the tournament one week and hold it as usual on Wednesday/Thursday with luncheon at 1PM on Thursday, November 10<sup>th</sup>.
  2. Hold the tournament during the originally scheduled week, but fish Tuesday and Wednesday with the luncheon held on at 1PM on Wednesday, November 2nd.
