Tournament Director's Report - Bill Walker

Program Director's Report - Bill Smith and Tom Tamanini

The board recognized Tom for the great job of organizing our February program with Ken Sturdivant. Ken's 2 hour discussion concerning electronics / GPS / sonar and both down and side imaging was very well received by the members that attended. Ken also conducted on the lake demonstrations of these units both Thursday (2 trips) & Friday (3 trips). 25 members took advantage of the on the water training. Bill Walker made arraignments for a boat slip for Ken. Tom hosted Ken at his house for both nights.

Ken has offered to come back some time in the future for 3 days and take out 3 members per day for \$300, \$100 each. This would be a 7 hour on the water hands on training. Tom will coordinate this activity and he indicated he has tentative dates for this activity the 3rd week of March, yet to be confirmed. The training sessions will be for club members only and will be operated out of Cane Creek. So far Tom has received 9 responses of interest to attend this course which would fill the 3 days. A 4th day could be added if 3 more members want to sign up.

The March program will again be a panel discussion. Tom will contact club members to obtain 4 or 5 members that would comprise the panel. If any board members have recommendations for panel members send your input to Tom and will contact them.
