

## **Cooling Water & Scattered Hard to Find Bass**

As the surface water temperature cools on Lake Keowee in the fall catching bass can be a real challenge and anything but predictable. It is recommended that you cover a lot of water until you locate a school of bass. This method also lets you pick up a lone bass or two. In order to do the best search there are certain lures that are the most dependable under this condition. The lures that are recommended are:

- Spinnerbaits
- Lipless crankbaits
- Top water walk the dog type
- And medium diving crankbaits

Lures that are not recommended are the more slow moving ones such as Jigs and worm rigs. But, if in your search you find bass on the bottom then these can be very effective.
