

Fishing Docks

Boat docks are great places to find fish, if you know how to fish them. If you know how to fish points pretty well, just think of a dock as a point and fish it the same way.

Not all points produce fish though and neither do all docks. Docks supported by large pilings will nearly always out produce floating docks. On Keowee fixed docks are unusual so floating docks are the game. Fish usually hold around or under floats. The outside corners are best. The best docks end near deep water, especially if someone has placed brush piles nearby.

Work along the edges and in the slip if there are no obstructions. A Texas rigged worm worked down the outside of the dock as close as you can get is very productive. Also, a wacky rigged worm is very effective. Unweighted trick worms worked slowly are also good producers. Spinning rods and reels are best for the unweighted worms.
